The Congress will open on Thursday 15th September at 9.30am (coffee from 9am) and will close at 1pm on Friday 16th September (followed by a lunch).

EFLA is delighted to announce that the keynote speaker for the opening session will be Dr. Marzenna Guz-Vetter, Deputy Head of Representation, Head of Political Sector, European Commission Representation in Poland.

In Session I following an overview on the state of play of REFIT and how this impacts EU food law, **Prof.**Małgorzata Korzycka and Dr. Paweł Wojciechowski (University of Warsaw) will explore whether a turbocharged mutual recognition can really solve the EU and global barriers to trade. Session II will focus on specific areas of the EU legal framework for food asking the question whether REFIT is really a motor or a block to innovation in the food sector. During this session experts from academia, industry and the legal profession will examine the recent novel foods legislation (**Prof. Andreu Palou**, University of Balearic Islands), foods for specific population groups (**Ms. Nicole Coutrelis**, Coutrelis & Associés), health claims and nutrient profiles (**Mr. Jean Savigny**, Keller & Heckman; **Mr. Graham Brookes**, ELC) and food supplements (**Mr. Patrick**Coppens, Food Supplements Europe; **Prof. Iwona Wawer**, Medical University of Warsaw. On day 2 the Congress will focus its attention of the price of consumer demand, with presentations from **Ms. Joanna**Krakowiak (Wardyński & Partners) on clean labelling, **Mr. Christian Jochum** (Austrian Chamber of Agriculture) on organic foods and **Dr. Tobias Teufer** (Krohn) on geographical indications. In the final session, **Ms. Elena**Todorova (Schönherr Bulgaria) and **Mr. Cristian Popa** (KUK Romania s.r.I) will explore enforcement procedures under REFIT.

The EFLA President, **Mr. Vicente Rodriguez-Fuentes** (Legal Agrifood Abogados) looks forward to welcoming you all to this year's EFLA congress.
